



## “Rededication”

*Holy to the Lord  
Exodus 34:12-26*

**Rededication includes our:**

### I. Connection – “lest thou make a covenant” (vs. 12-17)

*Participation in the:*

- A. **Wor** \_\_\_\_\_ - “the inhabitants in the land”
- B. **Wo** \_\_\_\_\_ – “For thou shalt worship no other god”
- C. **W** \_\_\_\_\_ – “take of their daughters unto thy sons”

### II. Celebration – “thou shalt observe the feast” (vs. 18-22)

*Participation promoting:*

- A. **Re** \_\_\_\_\_ - “thou camest out of Egypt”
- B. **Re** \_\_\_\_\_ – “thou shalt redeem with a lamb”
- C. **Re** \_\_\_\_\_ - “the seventh day thou shalt rest”

### III. Consecration – “appear before the LORD thrice” (vs. 23-26)

*Participation demonstrating:*

- A. **Hom** \_\_\_\_\_ – “all your men children appear before the LORD”
- B. **Hol** \_\_\_\_\_ – “not offer the blood...sacrifice with leaven”
- C. **Hon** \_\_\_\_\_ – “the firstfruits...bring unto the house of the LORD”

## Sentence Sermon:

*“Our salvation is receiving what God gives to us,  
Our dedication is giving to God what He desires from us.”*
