## Pridefully proclaiming your:

I. Victory – "ye have reigned as kings" (vs. 7-8)

Misplaced:

II. Virtue – "ye are honorable" (vs. 9-10)

- **B.** Sp\_\_\_\_\_\_ "We are fools for Christ's sake"
- C. Su\_\_\_\_\_ "we are despised"

III. Value – "the offscouring of all things" (vs. 11-13)

- **B. Bl**\_\_\_\_\_\_-"being reviled, we bless"
- *C. Be\_\_\_\_\_\_ "Being defamed, we intreat"*
