A Spiritual Disorder I Corinthians 11:13-22

#### Dysfunctional worship:

I.	<b>D</b> eviates – "It is a shame unto him"	(vs. 13-16)
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It disregards:

A. Com\_\_\_\_\_ – "Is it comely that a woman pray...uncovered"

**B.** Cr\_\_\_\_\_ – "Does not even nature itself teach you"

C. C\_\_\_\_\_ - "no such custom, neither the churches of God"

# II. Divides – "that there be divisions among you" (vs. 17-19)

It is:

A. Ha\_\_\_\_\_\_ – "not for the better, but for the worse"

**B.** He\_\_\_\_\_\_ – "there must be also heresies among you"

### III. Demeans – "I praise you not" (vs. 20-22)

Its attitude is:

**A.** S\_\_\_\_\_\_ - "every one takes before other his own supper"

**B.** S\_\_\_\_\_\_ – "despise ye the church of God"

C. S\_\_\_\_\_\_ – "and shame them that have not"
