I Corinthians 14:1-11

It is about the:

I. Communication – “for no man understands him” (vs. 1-3)

Our speech should:

- A. **E**_____ – “But he that prophesizes speaks to... edification”
- B. **E**_____ – “But he that prophesizes speaks to...exhortation”
- C. **E**_____ – “But he that prophesizes speaks to...comfort”

II. Church– “he that prophesizes edifies the church” (vs. 4-6)

Our speech has an :

- A. **E**_____ – “he that speaks in a tongue edifies himself”
- B. **E**_____ – “except he interpret... church may receive edifying”
- C. **E**_____ – “what shall I profit you, except I shall speak”

III. Consequence – “for you shall speak into the air” (vs. 7-11)

Our speech should be:

- A. **S**_____ - “who shall prepare himself to the battle”
- B. **S**_____ – “utter by the tongue words easy to be understood”
- C. **S**_____ – “If I know not the meaning... be a barbarian to me”
