



## **“Restoration”**

*When Others Sin  
Deuteronomy 9:15-21*

**It requires us to:**

**I. Inspect** –“And I look, and , behold, you had sinned” (vs. 15-17)

*Noticing God’s:*

**A. P** \_\_\_\_\_ - “*ye had sinned against the LORD your God*”

**B. Pr** \_\_\_\_\_ – “*and had made you a molten calf*”

**C. Pre** \_\_\_\_\_ – “*ye have turned aside quickly out of the way*”

**II. Intercede** –“the LORD hearkened unto me” (vs. 18-20)

*Praying about God’s:*

**A. Lo** \_\_\_\_\_ - “*And I fell down before the LORD*”

**B. La** \_\_\_\_\_ –“*because of all your sins which you all sinned*”

**C. Le** \_\_\_\_\_ –“*I prayed for Aaron also the same time*”

**III. Intervene**– “I took...stamped...ground...cast” (vs. 12-14)

*Taking action to:*

**A. Re** \_\_\_\_\_ - “*And I took your sin, the calf you had made*”

**B. Re** \_\_\_\_\_ –“*and stamped it and ground it very small*”

**C. Re** \_\_\_\_\_ –“*and cast the dust thereof into the brook*”

13. Who do you care enough about to intercede and intervene to restore them?
