*Exciting their:*

**II. Good** – “we know that the law is good” (vs. 8-10)

A. **Law** \_\_\_\_\_ - “for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly”

B. **La** \_\_\_\_\_ – “For whore mongers, them that defile themselves”

C. **L** \_\_\_\_\_ – “for liars, for perjured persons”

**III. Gospel** – “the glorious gospel ” (v. 11)

*Exalting what is:*

A. **G** \_\_\_\_\_ – “According to the glorious”

B. **G** \_\_\_\_\_ – “gospel of the blessed God”

C. **G** \_\_\_\_\_ – “which was committed to my trust”
