### The master desires us to:

I.	Cleanse – "purge himself from these"	(vs. 20-21)
----	--------------------------------------	-------------

Clean vessels are:

- **A.** Hon\_\_\_\_\_\_ "he shall be a vessel unto honour"
- C. H\_\_\_\_\_\_ "prepared unto every good work."
- II. Circumvent "the servant of the Lord must not strive" (vs. 22-24)

  Circumvent the:
  - A. For\_\_\_\_\_\_ "Flee also youthful lusts"

  - C. F\_\_\_\_\_\_ "knowing that they do gender strifes"
- III. Correct "the foundation of God stands sure" (vs. 18-19)

  Correcting for:
- **A.** Rep\_\_\_\_\_\_ -"In meekness instructing those that oppose"
- **B.** Re\_\_\_\_\_ "if God peradventure will give them repentance"
- **C.** *R*\_\_\_\_\_\_ "recover themselves out of the snare of the devil"
