Worship acknowledging the:

A. O_____ – “came the Word of God out from you?”

B. O_____ – “or came it unto you only”

C. O_____ – “are the commandments of the Lord”

III. Warranted – “forbid not to speak with tongues” (vs. 38-40)

Worship being:

A. Pri_____ - “Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy”

B. Pro_____ – “Let all things be done decently”

C. Pro_____ – “Let all things be done...in order”
