- B. **Pr**_____ – “every man as he purposes in his heart”
- C. **Pre**_____ – “God loves a cheerful giver”

II. Source - “to prove” (vs. 8-10)

Our source comes from :

- A. **Wh**___ – “God is able to make all grace abound toward you”
- B. **Wh**___ – “you, having all sufficiency in all things, may abound”

III. Success – “subjection unto the gospel of Christ” (vs. 11-15)

Our success is when there is:

- A. **En**_____ - “enriched in every thing to all bountifulness”
- B. **Ed**_____ – “this service...supplies the want of the saints”
- C. **Ex**_____ - “They glorify God for your professed subjection”
