C. **S**_____ – “another gospel which ye have not accepted”

III. Demonstration – “manifest among you in all things” (vs. 5-6)

A. **Ca**_____ - “I was not a whit behind the chiefest apostles”

B. **Co**_____ – “rude in speech, yet not in knowledge”

C. **Ch**_____ - “we have been thoroughly made manifest”
