<u>Kinds of Peace</u>	Dictionary (1966); inner, home, community, nations, nature, spiritual
What is peace?	What beauty contestants want or What was lost in the Garden (Genesis 3)?
<u>Old Testament</u>	Leviticus 7:11-18 (peace offerings); Isaiah 48:22 (not for the wicked); Psalm 119:165 (for law lovers); Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 (A time for); Micah 4:1- 4 (domestic tranquility); Isaiah 9:6 (Prince of Peace).
<u>Jesus Taught</u>	Mark 4:38, 39 (in the storm); Matt 5:9 (Blessed are); Matt 10: 34-39 (not peace but a sword); Matt. 24:3-8 (wars and rumors); John 16:33 (Peace in me)
<u>Off with his head</u>	John 18:1-11: Another garden; Betrayal; Armed Soldiers, Holy Fear, Peter's sword; Malchus's ear; Asymmetric spiritual warfare.
Peace be with you!	John 20:19-28: Locked doors; Fear; "I am sending you."; Holy Spirit given; Stubborn disbelief; "See my hands…"; "My Lord and my God" – Peace and Reconciliation.
Practical Peace	Galatians 5:22-24 (a fruit); I Peter 5:7 (He cares); Ephesians 4:17 (sun & wrath); I Corinthians 13:4-7 (patience, humility, selflessness, endurance, hope)
