



## ***“Faithful”***

*Being Committed*  
*II Timothy 1:13-18*

***It’s a commitment to:***

**I. Retain** – “Hold fast the form” (vs. 13-14)

*Retain your:*

- A. **D** \_\_\_\_\_ – “sound words, which thou hast heard of me”
- B. **De** \_\_\_\_\_ – “in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus”
- C. **Dep** \_\_\_\_\_ - “which was committed unto thee”

**II. Remain** – “of whom are Phygellus and Hermogenes” (v. 15)

*Remaining is often:*

- A. **Unn** \_\_\_\_\_ – “This thou knowest”
- B. **Unp** \_\_\_\_\_ – “that all they which are in Asia be”
- C. **Unr** \_\_\_\_\_ – “turned away from me”

**III. Refresh** – “refreshed me and was not ashamed” (vs. 16-18)

*Refreshing requires:*

- A. **P** \_\_\_\_\_ – “for he oft refreshed me”
- B. **P** \_\_\_\_\_ – “he sought me out very diligently, and found me”
- C. **P** \_\_\_\_\_ – “how many things he ministered unto me”
