Our community grows even though departures of many who are on work visas are not being renewed.

In July, our team organized a group camping weekend with several Hindu families.

We are now making audio recordings of our story-based messages about the life of the Lord Jesus and offering them as a podcast.

In October we celebrated “Festival of Lights” with over 30 people from our Indian community, as we gathered to worship the Lord Jesus. Sarah and I also visited 11 Indian families to distribute gifts of homemade traditional Divali treats.

The greatest honor is that the Lord Jesus has answered some of our prayers for our Hindu friends in timely ways that have exalted Him in their eyes as the God who answers prayer.
