### Clair & Mayann Longuevan - Avant Ministries

We are back after a very rewarding and safe trip to France, then Spain, and then back to France again. There were about 45 young people at the teenage English Cowboy Camp in Spain, where we spent a very active time (and we trust a fruitful week with them) from morning till midnight.

We have had a very busy summer and fall. Pray for us in our travels. Mayann has been and will be accompanying me on all our trips this summer and fall, so please pray for the knee and back pain that she experiences, especially when we travel.

We are now on a 12-day trip to Warroad, Minnesota, speaking to and singing at the Woodland Bible Church. Then we go to Oshkosh, Wisconsin, where we will also speak at both the morning and evening services.

Next year, the Lord willing, I will be leading a team of 10-12 people to Juneau, Alaska, to help construct a staff house at Echo Ranch Bible Camp, a camp staffed by Avant missionaries for over 50 years. Pray with us this fall and next spring, as I will be speaking in different churches and colleges that the Lord will raise up a team of people that would be willing to serve Him in Alaska from August 10-17, 2019.
