Coaching Darshan Alumni in India

Over that last several months, we've had the privilege of actively coaching two Darshan alumni who are living and working in two different cities in India. They will both be hosting college interns from the U.S. this summer, so we are coaching them to use some of the training content from the Darshan program. We see this as a precedent for how Darshan's circle of influence will continue expanding to reach more and more of those who really need this training.

Improving Darshan Training Methods

After running Darshan training events over the last six years, we are very confident in the existing training content. However, we need to improve some of the adult learning methods we use to teach that content. So, this week (April 29 to May 4) I am in Tyler, TX, attending a *Learning That Lasts* workshop which is "an intensive course for people who want to improve their teaching skills for adult learners of various cultures, learning styles, experiences, and educational backgrounds" (learninglasts.wordpress.com). I am excited to integrate what I'm learning into the Darshan training program over the next year.
