Missionary Update

Larry & Virginia McGuire – Trans World Radio, Elkhart, IN

The West Africa Transmitting Station (WATS) has been broadcasting for over a decade using a 100,000-watt AM transmitter. After several years of negotiation, TWR was recently granted government permission for the installation of an additional 200,000-watt AM transmitter to allow additional languages and more programs to be aired, reaching even more distant targets in West Africa.

Please **pray** for wisdom and safety for the technical teams involved with the installation of the transmitters for these two stations. The WATS site also requires an additional generator and erection of another tower.

The restoration of TWR's office in Cary, North Carolina, following the fire in December was completed in July and the project to convert the third floor into additional office space (that we helped with during part of April, all of May and one week in July) was completed a few weeks later. On October 11, a rededication service was held for the new and restored facilities that the Lord has provided.
